

Campo di Bocce of Livermore League Information



Who? Teams of 4 or more Bocce players. Teams can consist of co-workers, couples, families (ages 18 and up please), friends, all girls, all guys, ANYONE!

What? A recreational Bocce league for players of all skill levels

Where? Campo di Bocce of Livermore (outside on our beautiful patio)

When? Games are held weekly on Monday nights at 6:30pm and 8:30pm. We also have our Winery League on Wednesday nights at 7:30pm. (Call club for details) There are two seasons per year. The Spring season begins in March-April and ends in June. The Fall season starts in August. Game times will be 6:30 pm or 8:30pm (depending on the number of teams registered) and will vary week-to-week based on schedules provided at the beginning of the season. Specific timing requests cannot be guaranteed. Playoffs are held the last week of the season.

Why? For FUN, of course!

Fees: The fee is TBA per player. An average season is between 12 and 16 weeks. All fees must be paid prior to the first game of the season. There is no fee for Campo di Bocce of Livermore members. There is no fee for alternates. Campo di Bocce of Los Gatos members have a discounted rate. Any player that pays (dues) in full on or before the captains meeting (time & date TBA) will receive 10% "early registration" discount.

How to Sign Up: Sign-ups begin approximately one month prior to the start of the season. Returning teams may be given the opportunity to register before new teams.

1. Assemble your team - A team consists of 4 roster players and up to 2 alternates. If you are an individual looking to join a team, contact Heather at (925) 249-9800 or heather@campodibocce.com.
2. Choose a night - Monday night is typically for beginners, and Wednesday is for the Winery players (Wineries only). (Up to 16 teams will be accepted for each night).
3. Obtain a league registration form, at our facility, or by calling (925) 249-9800 or email Heather@campodibocce.com. Completed registration forms should be submitted via fax (eFax# (925) 605-3886), email, mail, or in person.
4. Attend the Captain's meeting (held approximately 1 week prior to the start of the season) Date and time to be announced.
5. Pay any applicable league fees.
